



## **Inland Empire Hispanic Leadership Council Scholarship Description**

### **Mission:**

The IEHLC, founded in 2007 represents the Counties of Riverside and San Bernardino. The council is a regional non-profit organization that has come together to work on improving the quality of life for the communities of the Inland Empire. The Council centers its work on the areas of business, education, health and public policy.

### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide regional financial support in the San Bernardino and Riverside Counties to broaden and enhance civic leadership among students enrolled in a college or university listed below. The program's intent is to offer monetary support to participating college students in a community college, undergraduate or graduate program. These students must be enrolled in a program or have a desired career surrounding one or more of our four pillars: 1) Business, 2) Education, 3) Public Policy or 4) Health. Students have the freedom to explain how their career aspirations may intersect with the pillars above even if their programs do not directly relate.

### **Process and Funding Proposal:**

The IEHLC scholarship committee will coordinate with participating colleges and universities to dispense scholarship(s) to selected IEHLC scholarship candidates. The candidates will meet with the IEHLC Executive Board to explain their background and aspirations. Then the IEHLC Board will choose 12 candidates, one from each college and university listed below.

A \$700 scholarship will be awarded to six individuals from the community colleges listed below and a \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded to six individuals from the universities listed below.

### **Eligible Community Colleges:**

1. Riverside City College
2. Moreno Valley College
3. Mount San Jacinto College
4. Crafton Hills College
5. Norco College
6. San Bernardino Valley College

### **Eligible Universities:**

1. University of California, Riverside
2. California State University, San Bernardino
3. University of La Verne
4. University of Redlands
5. California Baptist University
6. La Sierra University

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

Students meeting the following requirements may be considered for this scholarship:

- Student must be of Latino/Hispanic heritage
- Student must be enrolled at a college or university listed above
- Student must have a 3.0 GPA or higher
- Student must be a California resident who lives within the boundaries of San Bernardino or Riverside County
- Student must be enrolled in a program or have career aspirations geared towards business, education, public policy or health.

### **Application Instructions:**

1. Include most recent official or unofficial high school or college transcript
2. If a senior in high school, include a letter that shows proof of acceptance to the colleges or universities listed above.
3. Request one letter of recommendation:
  - One academic letter from a faculty member or professional reference who can speak to your writing, research abilities and your general academic performance.
4. Prepare a resume describing your work, volunteer and academic experience, demonstrating why you meet the qualifications for the scholarship.
5. Complete and submit the attached application and all requirements to the IEHLC Scholarship Committee at [Info@iehlc.org](mailto:Info@iehlc.org). Please title the subject, "IEHLC 18/19 Scholarship\_(Insert your first & last name)".
6. The Scholarship Committee will hold interviews of selected candidates. The candidate will be notified within 4 weeks after application deadline.
